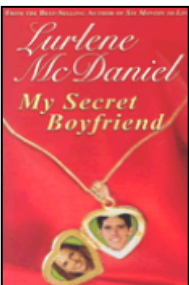
Big Field by Mike Lupica

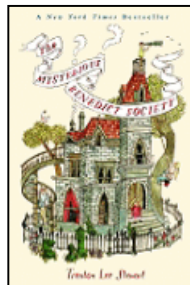
Last Dance by Lurlene McDaniel
