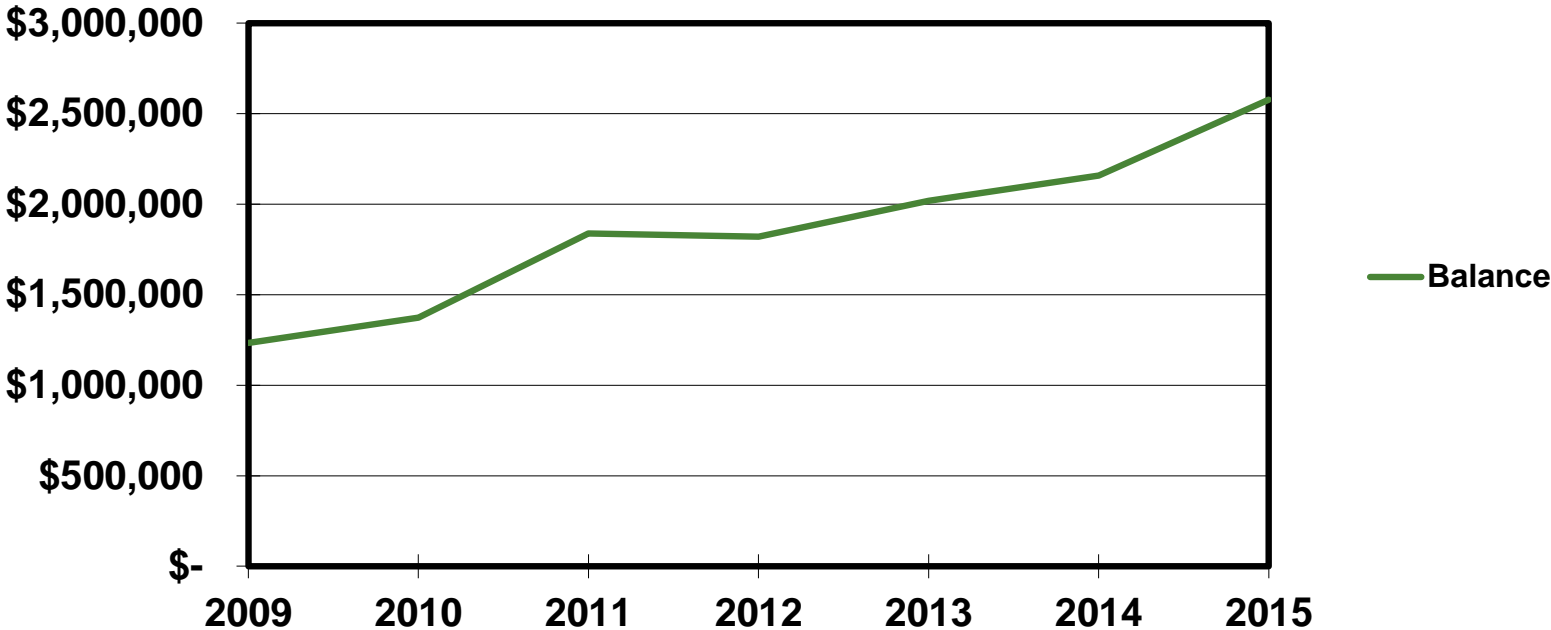

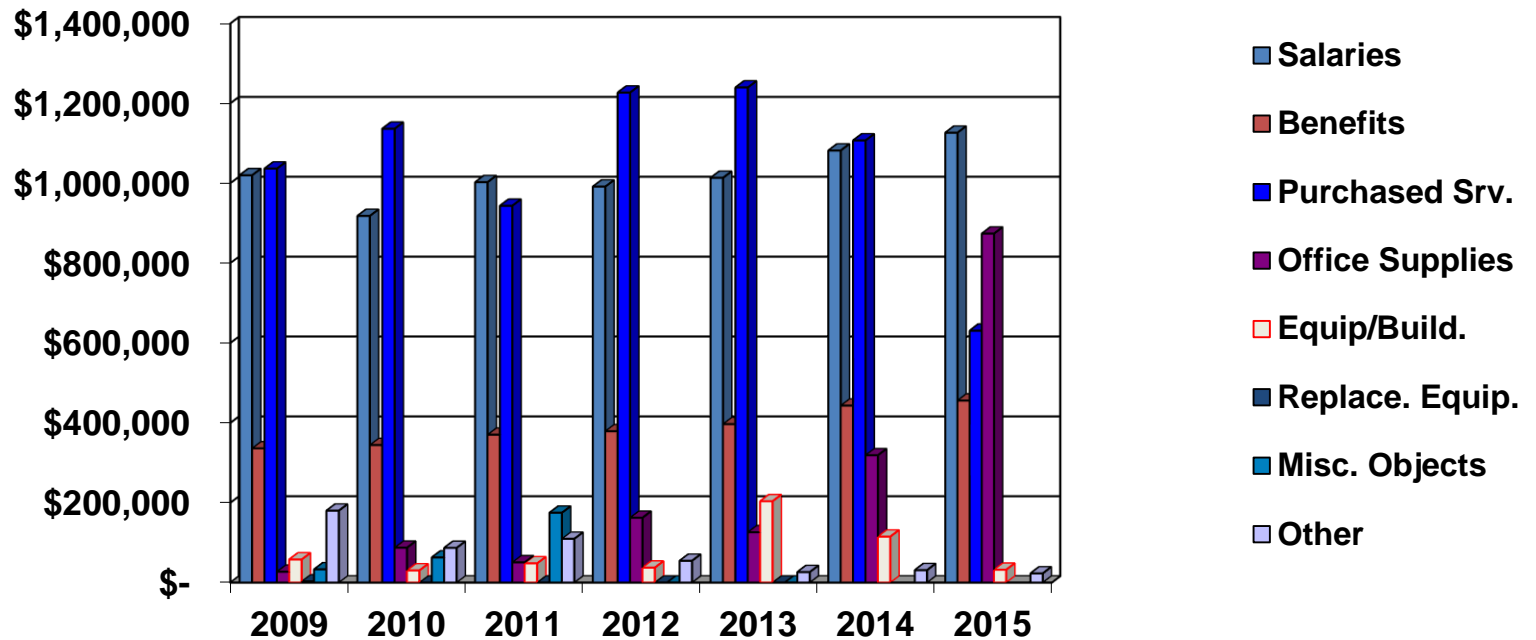

Fiscal Year 2015

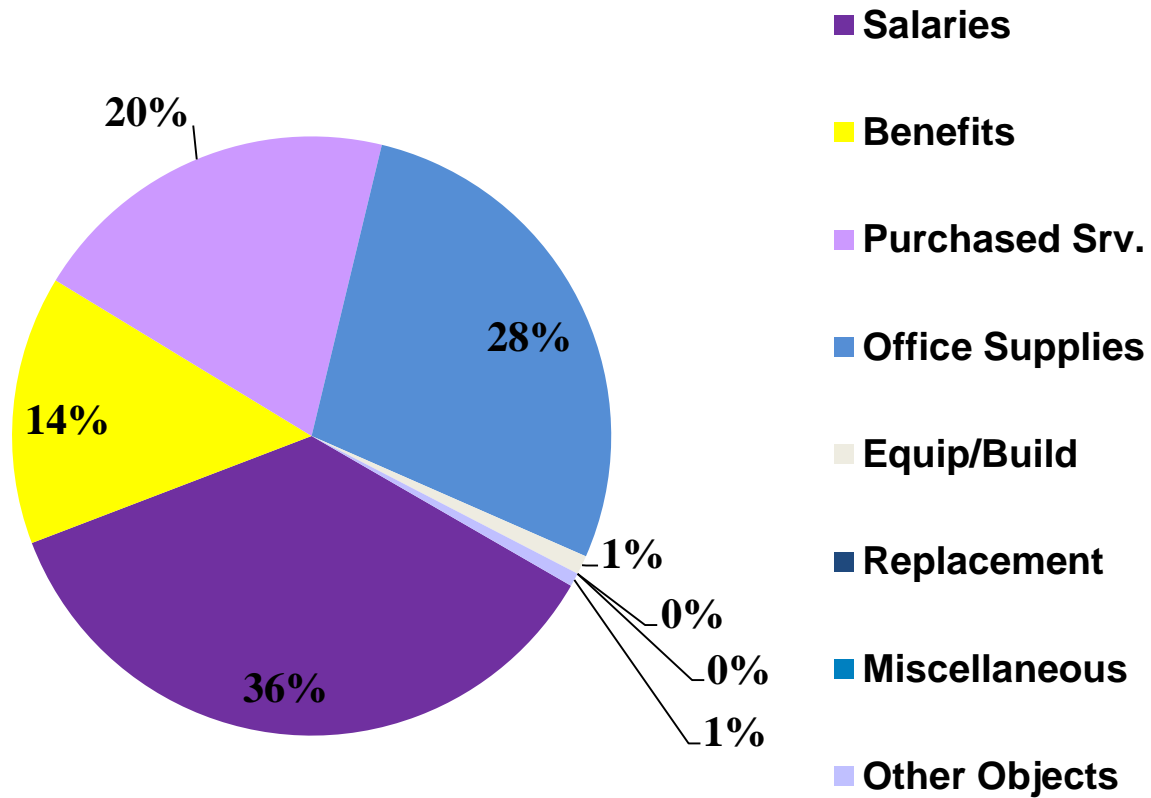

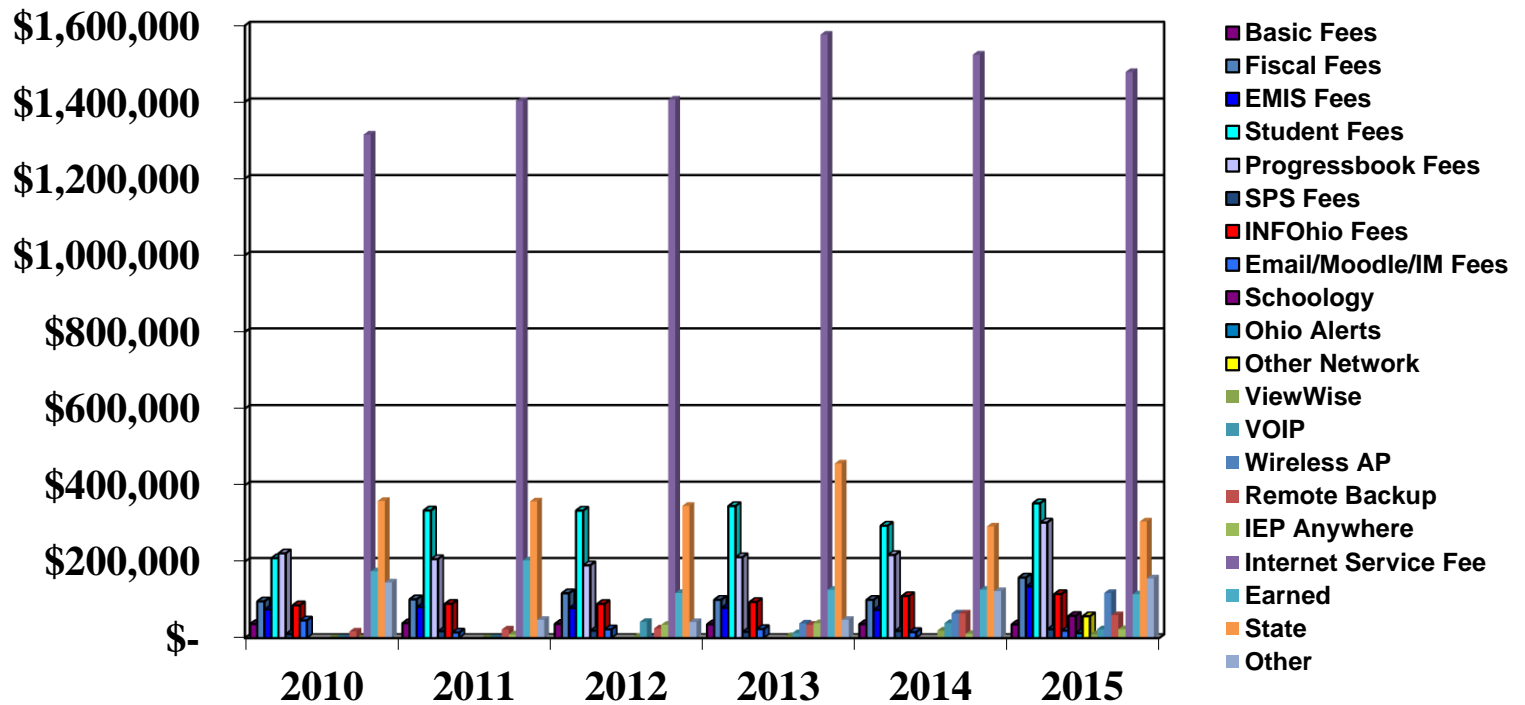
Expenses



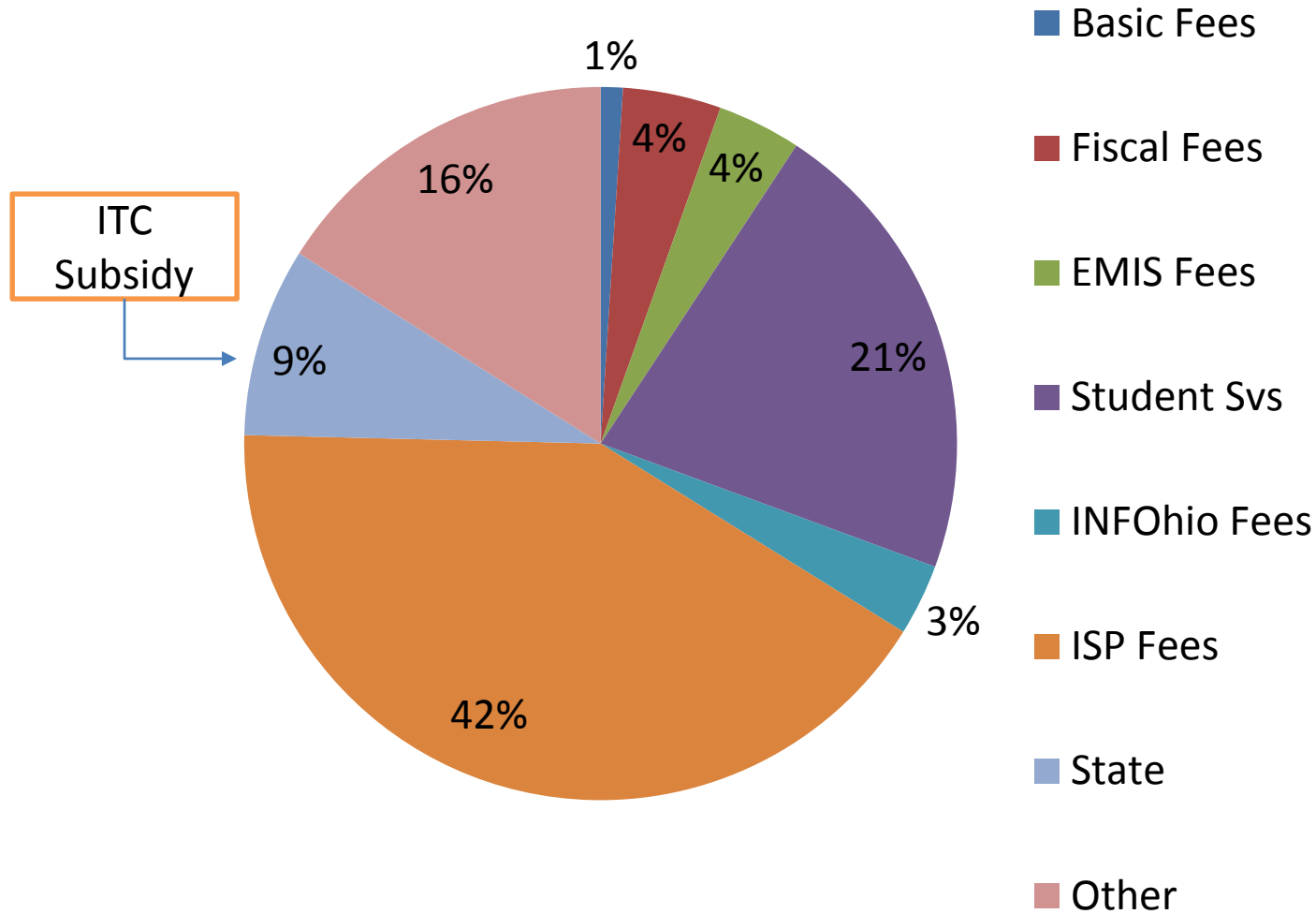
2015 Expenses



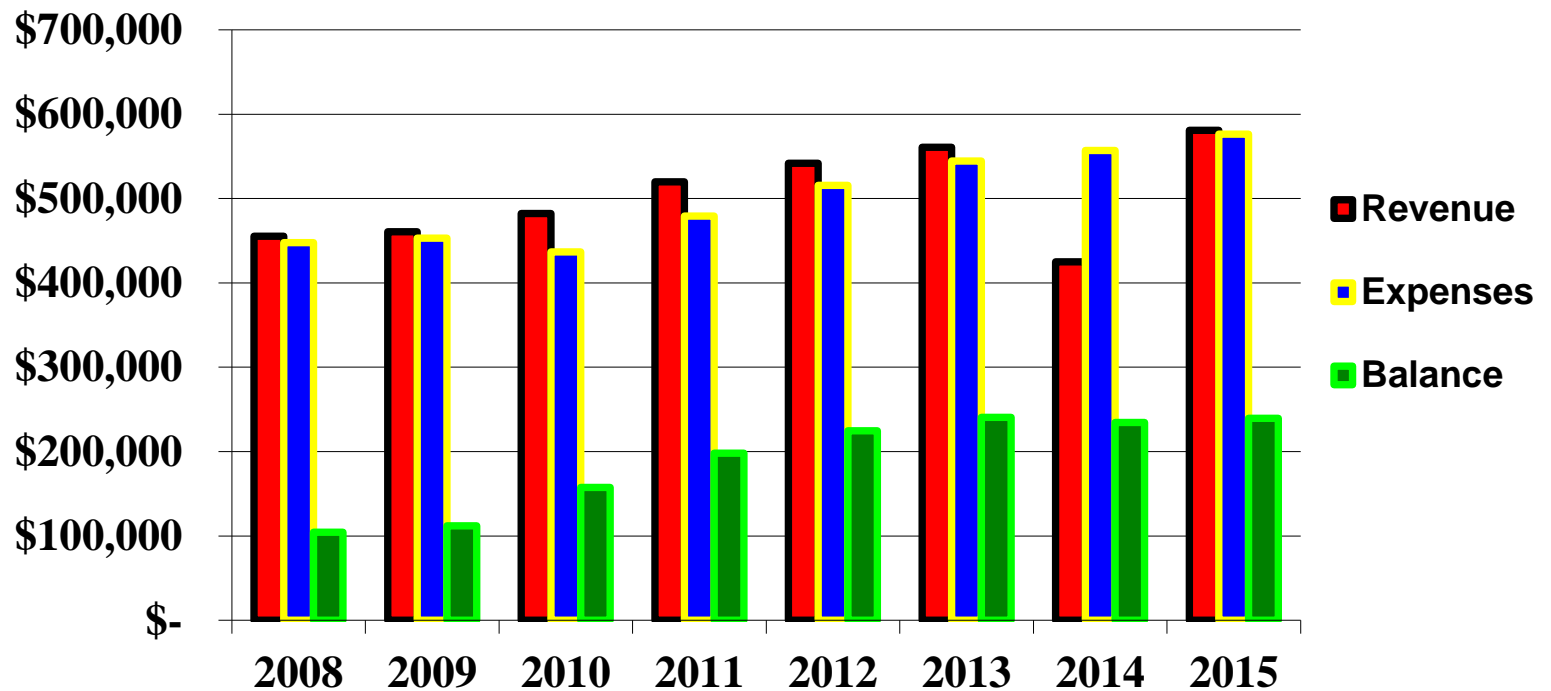
Revenue



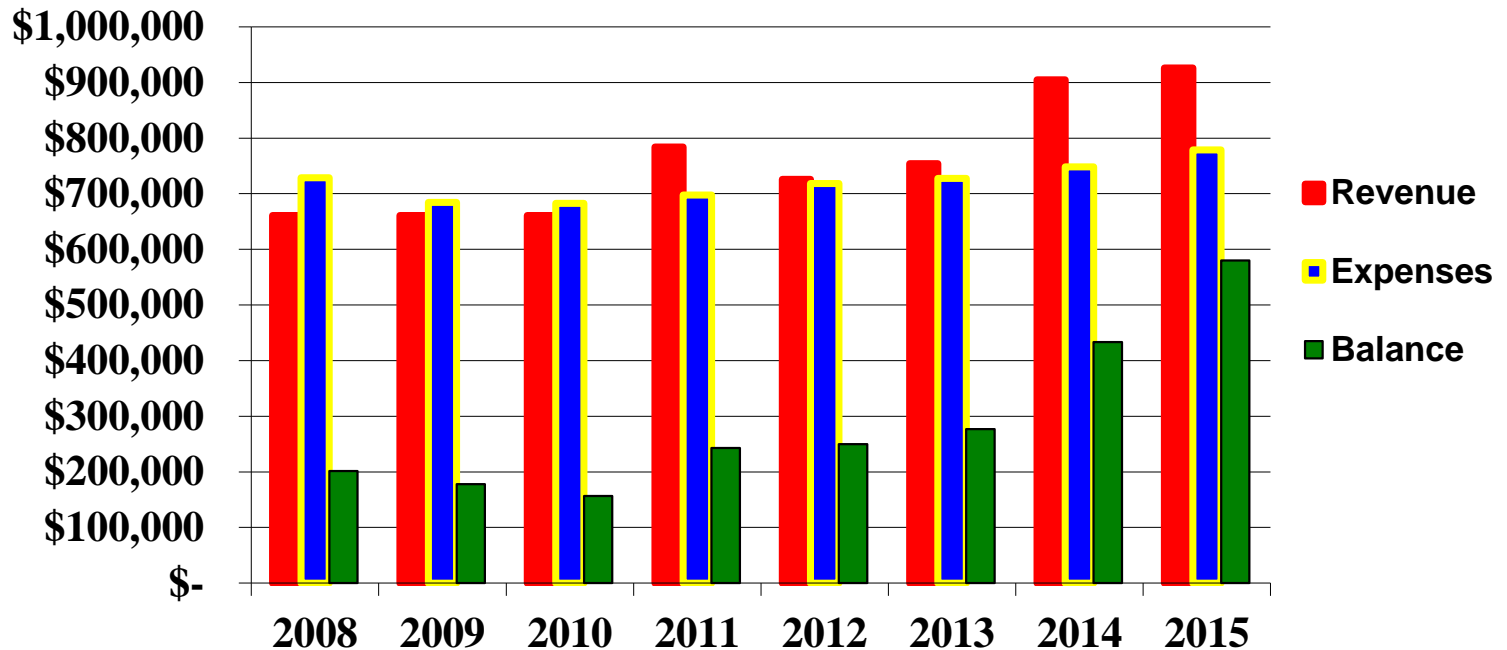
2015 Revenue

MUNIS Update

- ❑ How did we get here
 - ❑ NOACSC Board has approved contract with Tyler Technologies
 - ❑ ~28 Members plus NOACSC
 - ❑ Waves 1 thru 6
 - ❑ Commitment Letters going out tomorrow
 - ❑ Staffing
 - ❑ When P.O.'s have been received to cover \$517,000 - formal contract will be signed
 - ❑ If you would like to receive a commitment letter, contact Ray Burden or Fiscal Staff
- ❑ Fees
 - \$6.50/Student Annual Fee
 - \$6.00 Tyler/MUNIS licensing fee
 - \$.50 NOACSC fee for COB
 - \$20.00/student implementation fee
 - For every additional 1000 students committed, implementation fee goes down \$.50 per student
 - But...
 - If all NOACSC members were to commit to the MUNIS project
 - Implementation fee goes down to \$10.00 per student
 - \$9,625 Fixed fee
 - Data Conversion
 - Forms

State Software (USAS/USPS)

- ❑ SSDT has committed to a 1/1/2016 release candidate and a district converted in spring of 2016
- ❑ ODE has created an MCOECN/OASBO Oversight committee for the SSDT – First meeting Nov. 3
- ❑ NOACSC is committed to the success and future of State Software
- ❑ Suggestion: After district (spring of 2016) is converted - create NOACSC State Software conversion project team of interested Treasurers



Then & Now

□ 1997

- 18 years ago NOACSC Director presented status of T-1 lines
- Internet Access to 8 grade and above
- At best NOACSC total network capacity was 100m

□ 2015

- Internet Access is ubiquitous
- All Fiber circuits
- Network capacity of 15g (15,000m)



Then & Now

□ 2004

- VAX was 5 years old and SAN was new
 - \$500,000 investment

□ 2015

- Virtualized VAX and disk storage
 - \$5,000 Server
 - \$10,000 Software



Internet of Things

- ❑ 1993 – 1st Web Browser
- ❑ 1994 – Installed a 20m Hard Drive
- ❑ 2015 – Estimated 10,000 Exabytes of digital storage in the world
 - Giga, Tera, Peta, Exa, Zetta
- ❑ Where/What is or will be generating this data
 - Goods
 - Objects
 - Machines
 - Appliances
 - Vehicles
 - Animals
 - People (Wearables)
 - Plants
 - Soil

❑ Not to mention what we already know

- PC's, Laptops, Tablets, Cellphones
- Cars
 - Web-enabled
 - Satellite Radio
- Delivery Trucks
- Medical Monitors in the home

❑ By 2020

- 30 to 50 billion Internet connected devices on the planet



Internet of Things

❑ Not just Tech Indulgence

❑ Impact

– Short Term

- Energy Management (HVAC, Power)
- Security Controls

– Mid to Long Term

- Automatic Attendance
- Driver-less Buses

– Longer Term

- Recognition
- Passwords will be obsolete

– Redundancy

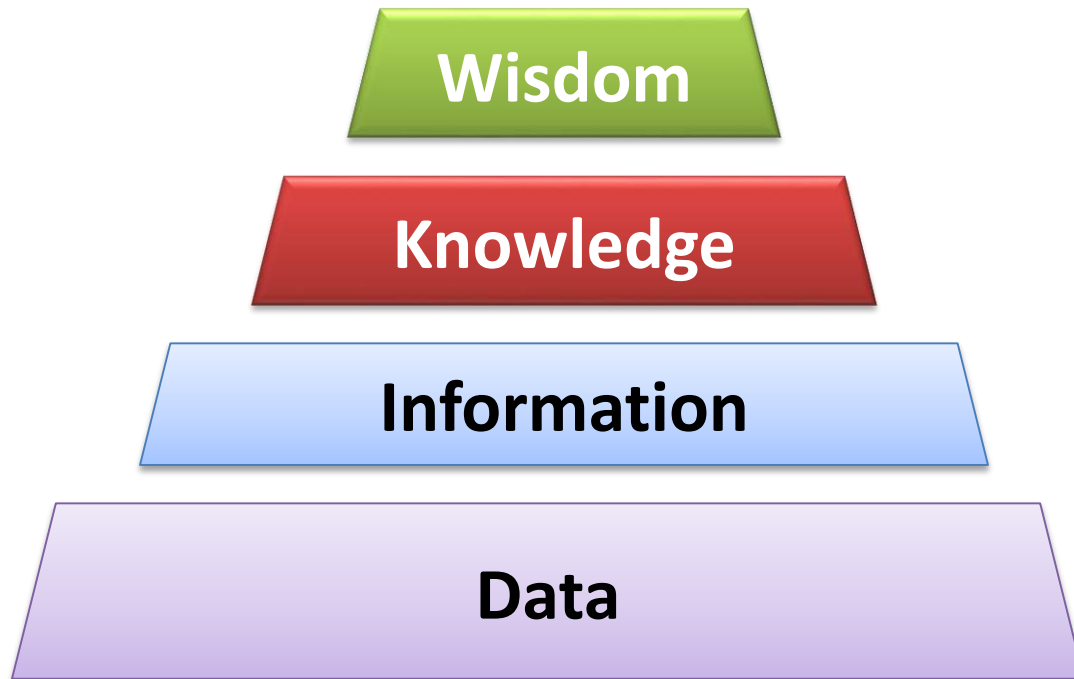
- When do we reach 99.999%?

A Little History

NOACSC as a legal entity

- ❑ 1979/1980 – OECN in law
- ❑ A-Sites/ITCs – Cooperative: Consortia & COGs
- ❑ Originally 28 A-Sites, Today 21
 - Dissolutions, Mergers
- ❑ NOACSC Formed as Consortium
 - Fiscal Agents: 1980 to 1986 – AC BOE
 1986 to 2012 – Van Wert BOE/WB ESC
- ❑ Location, location, location
- ❑ NOACSC legally changes to Council of Governments (COG)
 - July 1, 2012



Legal Status of COG

□ Primary Benefits

- NOACSC Board of Directors is true governing board and owner of Assets
- Liability for NOACSC ends with Board
 - Primarily protected via “Indemnification”
 - However, strong Insurance policy in place (Stolly & Ohio School Plan thru Hylant Group)
- Business Flexibility
 - Colocation Agreement with TSC
 - Ohio Alerts to Private Business
 - Can carry debt or issue bonds (ACCESS & NWOCA used this to build private fiber networks)

□ Secondary Benefits

- Protection from Regionalization
- Co-opitetion with other ITCs

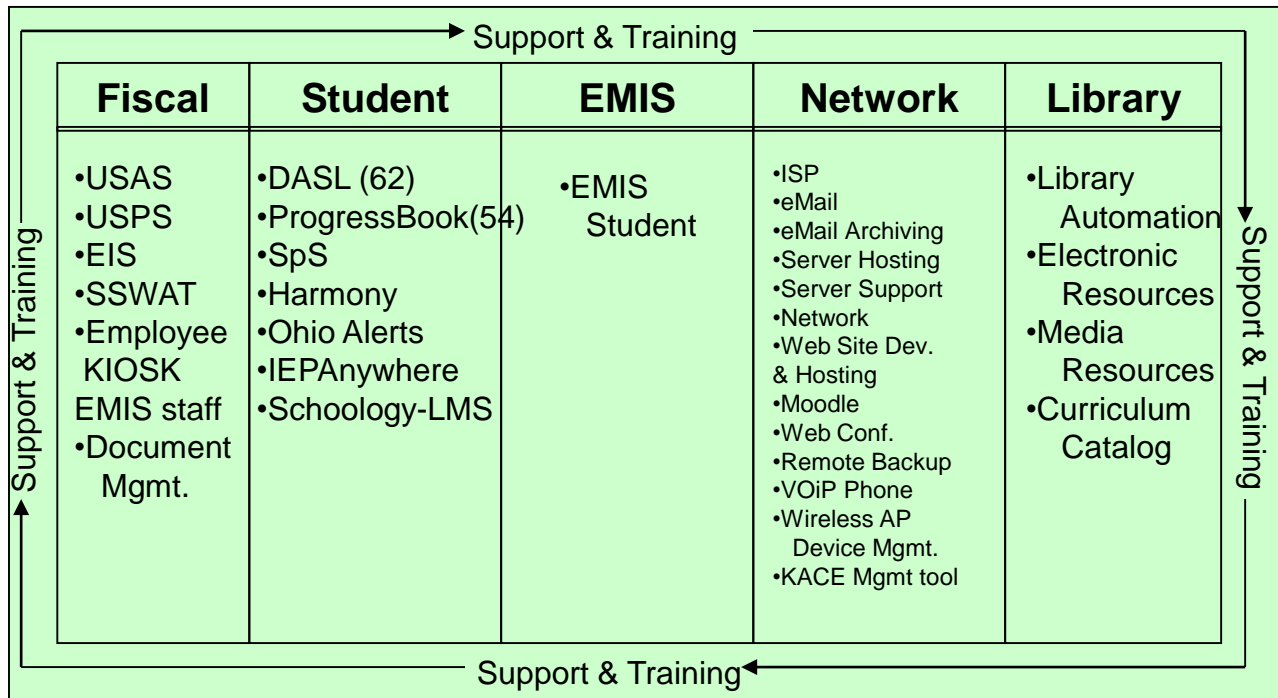
Services and Org. Chart - 1984

- ❑ Financially simple organization (one fund)
- ❑ Services & Support – Complex and Constantly Changing
 - Fiscal – SERS, STRS, ACA, Turnover, EMIS changes (Staff)

 - Student – DASL/PB: 4 releases per year with many enhancements, LMS
