Will assist the webmaster in developing and maintaining the INFOhio website and our instructional web tools like IMatrix, GO! Ask, Act, Achieve, R4S - Research for Success, IWonder and the Digital Video Collection. Will help support the software components and virtual servers used to deliver the SirsiDynix Symphony Integrated Library System. Will assist with testing, implementation and rollout of new SirsiDynix BLUEcloud products such as BC Central, BC Cataloging, BC Circulation, BC Search, MOBILECIRC and e-Resource Central. Special assignments may include working with the Instructional Team, vendors and partner agencies to create new products and evaluate existing INFOhio services.
