

The recent system updates included new features for Attendance Reporting.

- ♦ When you add/edit an absence for a student through the Daily Absence List screen or the Student's School Absences screen, you now see a Qualifier field that pre-populates with the value tied to the Absence Type Code being used.

From this screen, you can modify an existing absence event.

If you do not enter a Time In and/or Time Out for Absence Type Codes that have a Qualifier of Late/Tardy or Partial, they do not count toward the student's absence thresholds.



House Bill 410 related reports are now available within the Attendance folder in the Analytics Hub.




The screenshot displays the 'Attendance' section of the Analytics Hub. It includes a summary of absence thresholds, process warnings, and various daily and monthly attendance reports.
